THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK



It was uncomfortable and cold. But I don't regret that night I spent under the stars in a German field.

We were awaiting Holy Mass to be celebrated in the morning by Pope Benedict. This was during World Youth Days in Cologne in 2004, which inspired Mary Cahill, myself and others to start JACY on our return to Jersey.

Next weekend's event, Spirit on the Rock, was an idea that came out of the Youth Days Pilgrimage to Sydney in 2008. The young pilgrims wanted to come back and share a taste of what they had experienced. The idea was to bring young people together for a weekend of catechesis, fun and witness.

This has also become an event for families, with children from Year 7 upwards. It seeks to make faith normal in home life, rather than 'doing God' only in church. The programme is radical. It will look at the challenges our young people experience with the question: "What would Jesus do?"

Those taking part will look at social justice and the moral teaching of the church, and how it is possible to live these teachings. This is a fabulous opportunity and I am only

sad that many parents don't enable their children and young people to attend. Of course, their homework is important and so is sport. But they need to exercise their spirit as well as their mind and their body. Otherwise they will not be holistic individuals.

In today's gospel, Jesus showed his wounds to his disciples as a sign of his love. We need to touch his wounds in the lives of many of our children and young people, sometimes damaged by their parents break up; seduced away from Mass by easy money from jobs for teenagers; minds twisted by violence, pornography, witchcraft and other negative aspects of the Internet, which otherwise has been such a positive gift to mankind.

Never have we more needed our Catholic Youth Ministry. Whether it is the meetings of JaCy on Friday evenings, the Confirmation sessions, Spirit on the Rock or the World Meeting of Families in Dublin this summer, the opportunities are there. **Remember the three B's?** Young people need to develop a sense of **belonging**, which precedes **believing** and **behaving**.

ROSARY ON THE COAST

On **Sunday 29 April** at 3pm, thousands of Catholics will gather around the coasts of the British Isles to pray the Rosary for Peace, Life and Faith.
