## THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

I couldn't believe our good fortune this summer. Firstly, that the Bishop had so generously given us his Vicar General and Cathedral Dean, Canon Dominic Golding, whom we had long hoped would be appointed as my successor. Secondly, that the Cardinal had indicated that he might, at my request, give us Father Cristiano Braz to work alongside Canon Dominic, with particular responsibility for our Portuguese Catholic community.

Unfortunately, the Cardinal's advisers believed that Cristiano, who has been working in a Neo-catechumenate project in Texas, should not come to Jersey but return to work in a parish in Westminster diocese. So my hopes were dashed. It was my last throw of the dice after 19 years trying to secure a suitable priest to shepherd our huge number of Portuguese Catholics.

When writing to Portuguese Bishops or when writing to the Cardinal Archbishop of Westminster, I quoted the words we hear in this Sunday's gospel: *Jesus 'saw a large crowd; he took pity on them because they were like sheep without a shepherd...'*

For 19 years I have tried without language skills to shepherd all our immigrants, particularly the Portuguese, as the Polish

have Father Wieslaw as their shepherd. I have built up good relations with those who worship with us and those we rarely see except for First Communions, Confirmations, Weddings and Funerals. On Madeira Day recently I was thanked with presentations from the Mayor of Funchal and the local St Helier/Funchal Twinning Committee.

Not only am I now leaving them, but so is our town office manager, whom they know as Dona Manuela. She is not only their interpreter, but the one who deals with so many requests for paperwork connected with the sacraments and she enables liaison with the diocese of Funchal in Madeira.

I am sure Canon Dominic and Fr Ross, along with Fr Benjamin and Sister Paola of the Bethany Community, will do their best for all our communities. But, conscious that none of us can achieve everything, we need to place our trust in the Lord who is our Good Shepherd. He is the one who can guide us along the right path, even through the valley of darkness. For *'You are there with your crook and your staff; with these you give us comfort'*.
