## THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

It is irritating on the radio to hear people referring to organisations they belong to by the initials, which are called acronyms. The same can apply to our humble church newsletter.

Well, someone has asked me what **EST** is and where it lives and sleeps and meets, so I feel I should give an answer. First of all, it is not extra-terrestrial, but a down-to-earth gathering of human beings. It is a group set up within our parish at the request of our Bishop, which should give you a few clues. So what is it?

**E** is for evangelisation which means faith sharing, taken from the word '*evangelio*' meaning gospel. **S** is for strategy which means planning and organising. **T** is for team, like Jesus' own team of 12 Apostles. So the EST in Jersey has 12 members. They are a cross section of women and men from across our Island Parish, recommended by your clergy.

The Bishop's idea is that we work together to devise ways and means of promoting our Catholic faith, both to deepen an understanding of it among our own people, as

well as developing an effective outreach in sharing the Catholic faith with those who seek to make a spiritual home among us. That's why we launched Sycamore last year. But not this year, as we are currently developing the RCIA. Yes, more initials, meaning the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, offering a journey of faith that leads to Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist.

After an attempt at street evangelisation in town before Christmas, offering mulled fruit juice and mince pies in the cold rain, our EST is returning to basics. Currently we are reviewing the way parents are prepared for their child's baptism, so that this sacrament is understood as the beginning of the child's and the parents' relationship with Jesus and the Catholic Church, not the end with no follow-up, as is so often the case.
