

Pastoral Letter for world vocation day - Sunday 2nd May 1965

Found in the Sacristy at Sacred Heart:

"The world has need of the Priest and the Religious... like the Good Samaritan holding in his arms the half-dead man whom he will not leave, because he has been sent to help and save him... If God, in His loving wisdom, has arranged things in this way - that the world should need the priest and the religious in order to be saved - then, surely, He will hear and answer our prayers. So many priests are needed in the world today. In our own Diocese of Portsmouth, the shortage of clergy has become acute: yet our own situation cannot compare with other parts of the world, where countless thousands cry out for the services of the priest and religious.

First of all [World Vocation day] is directed to parents. The fostering of a vocation is, to a large extent, in your hands. It is by your rich and living Catholic faith that you direct the thoughts of your children towards the service of God. Realise what an honour it would be if God called one of your children to the priesthood or the religious state, and the blessings this would bring on you and your family. Let your home be one where the seed of a vocation can be sown and bear fruit."

Clergy Training Fund

There will be a Second Collection this Sunday for the Clergy Training Fund, which supports our seminarians through their seven-year training for the priesthood, including the 12 men currently in training, for the duration of their six- or seven-year journey to ordination. Each seminarian participates in a comprehensive programme of formation intellectually, pastorally, humanly and spiritually. These are the men who will baptize and catechize the coming generations, and care for us on our pilgrim way: our generosity today is a legacy to the Church of tomorrow. To sustain each seminarian costs around £30K each year.

Saint of the Week St Anselm

Born in northern Italy he died on 21 April 1109 in Canterbury, having been archbishop there for 16 years. He was often in dispute with the English king over the Church's independence; twice he was exiled. His theological writings and organising of church life have had an influence that has endured.
